

**Town of Baltimore
Board of Selectman Meeting
November 7, 2018**

Attending: Carl Spaulding, Orson Kendall, Wayne Wheelock, Loreen Billings, Kevin Gould, Sandy Rich, Walter Rich, John Lomachinsky, Dan Cox and Deb Bean.

The meeting was brought to order at 7:00 P.M.

Comments and Concerns- None.

Weathersfield Police Chief William Daniels presented information regarding the Weathersfield Police offering patrolling and other duties to our Town. Cavendish and Reading are interested in a similar collaboration. There could be grant dollars available for some vehicle patrolling. This would need to be presented to the voters at Town Meeting.

Carl Spaulding of the Snowmobile Club asked permission for the club to use our roads for the groomer and connecting with other trails as in previous years. Bud questioned the lack of visibility of sheriffs. Carl explained that the officers patrol the trails on snowmobiles and there is little presence of vehicles on the roads. The Selectboard remained concern about traveling on our roads. Carl said he would present our concerns to the Club. Bud made a motion to continue to allow the club to use our roads as in previous years. Motion seconded and carried.

Chris Yurek of SWCRPC handed out copies of the MRGP (Municipal Roads General Permit) road erosion inventory report. This is a multi (20) year project and we can work on different areas as time goes on. Bud noted we will be starting our budgeting process soon, but are still at least a year out.

Secretary's Report- Motion made and seconded to accept minutes. Carried

Treasurer's Report- Motion made and seconded to accept report. Carried.

Delinquent Tax Collector- No report.

Road Commissioner- Orson has been finishing up with grading. Gurneys rolled the roads at the same time. There was discussion about the use of the roller, including its cost, effectiveness etc.

Solid Waste- Wayne had copies of the Recycling Coordinator's Report for October 2018

Old Business- Wayne wondered about a sign for the newly designated "Old Shincracker Lane". Bud will get contact information to order one, and Orson will review the roads in case we need others. Dan inventoried the old/damaged trees in town and had a plan for removal. He would need someone for traffic control. It was agreed to start.

New Business- The next meeting will be December 5th. There will be a hearing for the Solar Amendment followed by the regular meeting. Preliminary budgets for 2020 will be started.
