Board of Selectman Meeting
August 1, 2018**

Attending: Orson Kendall, Wayne Wheelock, Sandy Rich, Walter Rich, John Lomachinsky, Dan Cox and Deb Bean.

The meeting was brought to order at 7:00 P.M.

Comments and Concerns- Sandy mentioned that she had heard that several people had gotten flat tires.

Delinquent Tax Collector- A message had been received from Janet that there remains one unpaid tax bill with balance of \$22.92.

Secretary's Report- Motion made and seconded to accept minutes. Carried

Treasurer's Report- Motion made and seconded to accept report. Carried.

Road Commissioner- It will cost \$1,600.00 to do the roadside mowing. A motion was made, seconded and carried to proceed. As we haven't mowed for a couple years, it was agreed even though the cost was a little over our budgeted amount.

As we need to minimize damage to cars' tires it was suggested to gravel the road 1 to 1 ½ inches to cover the sharper stones. M&M, Gurney's and Wilson should be contacted, and we should also hold off applying chloride until after the gravel is added.

John said several people have commented on a tree marked near his house. Dan has been busy with the storms. We should prioritize the trees in town to remove the worse ones first.

Sandy saw several kids riding on a small vehicle. Orson, as constable, is encouraged to talk with them.

Solid Waste- Wayne had copies of the Recycling Coordinator's Report for July 2018 and the preliminary amendment draft for solar siting and composting.
