July 10, 2019**

The meeting was brought to order at 7:00 P.M.

**Comments and Concerns-** Janet wondered if the Town had a flag to display. Deb will check. It was noted that Flag Rules require that a flag be lighted if left out after darkness.

**Secretary's Report-** Motion made and seconded to accept minutes. Carried.

**Treasurer's Report-** Motion made and seconded to accept report. Carried.

**Delinquent Tax Collector-** The balance for the 3 outstanding accounts is \$5,323.60. .

**Road Commissioner-** Orson felt we may need chloride and will check with Allstate. Sandy sent them a contract which has not been returned.

Grant work can begin as of July 1, 2019. Orson will check on the Jarvis bid.

A motion was made and seconded to adopt those standards of the New Town Bridges and Roads Standards which are required. Motion carried and the New Town Bridges and Roads Standards were adopted as noted. Document was signed

In reference to the Austin pond site, the Selectboard would like a letter from Keven outlining his contacts and discussions with the State.

**Solid Waste-** Wayne had copies of the Recycling Coordinators Report for June 2019.

**Old Business-** We should be proactive in securing new Town Officials. A notice will be sent with the Tax Bills and included on the Town's website and Facebook page. For anticipated openings, we need a letter of intent.
