**Delinquent Tax Collector-** (Called in) The balance is \$5,258.26. Letters will be going out this week.

**Road Commissioner-** The road held up well and there is no reports of tire damage. A lot of sand has been put on the road. The Selectboard has implemented revised Road Commissioner duties. The Road Commissioner will operate the equipment and maintain the road and will receive the same compensation. The Selectboard will set agenda items, permits, highway related costs, budgets and assist in meeting with contractors.

Orson will maintain the equipment and operate the Town Grader. Wayne will help with Access Permits, attend contractor meetings and assist with Grant applications.

Highway Grant for culverts: Bud has given to Megan, but hasn't heard back yet. The amount was estimated and included an extra \$400 for unanticipated expenses.

Wayne had copies of the Recycling Coordinators Report for May 2019.
