Old Business- Kevin met with Chief Thompson regarding the hydrants. They will be flushed twice a year, and in addition, they will be putting new heads on them to work with newer connections. No one contacted Corrigan's about their tree. Dan will check to see if it's in the Town's right of way and if it's a danger to traffic. He will also check the tree near Lomachinsky's. Bud hasn't heard about the grant for replacing culverts. It is for work done after July 1, 2016.
