

**Town of Baltimore  
Board of Selectman Meeting  
December 7, 2016**

*Attending: Janet Kendall, Wayne Wheelock, Sandy Rich, Orson Kendall, Debbie Griswold, Walter Rich, Kevin Gould, Dan Cox and Deb Bean.*

The meeting was brought to order at 7:00 P.M.

**Comments and Concerns-** One resident's tax bill has two parcels omitted. This occurred when multiple parcels were combined into one bill. The resident brought this to the listers' attention. It was agreed not to charge them a penalty nor interest, and Janet noted she could work with them to regarding a payment schedule.

**Secretary's Report-** Motion made and seconded to accept minutes. Carried.

**Treasurer's Report-** Motion made and seconded to accept report. Carried.

**Delinquent Tax Collector-** Janet submitted her report which indicated 3 remaining accounts totaling \$4,879.56. She also got the warrant for delinquent accounts for the new tax year totaling \$17,024.93.

**Road Commissioner-** He has been working on opening a culvert. It clogs with leaves and although water is flowing through, there is still more to do. Kevin received a call Wednesday that the roads weren't plowed early enough. Orson said Gurney's sanded but did not plow that day, as there was limited snow. Better Roads has processed our grants and we received a direct deposit into the Highway account. Bud will review the amounts to determine what needs to be transferred into the Highway Contingency account. He also had a contract from Gurney's for the 2017/18 winter season. The price is the same and they will continue to handle snow removal at the Town Office at no additional charge. Bud will let them know that we now have a bus stop in town and extra care may be needed in that area.

**Planning Commission-** Wayne had copies of Act 174 which addresses energy options and the need for inclusion in the Town Plan.

**Solid Waste-** Wayne had copies of the Recycling Coordinator's Report for November 2016.

**Old Business-** Kevin contacted Russ Thompson regarding a new contract. It should be sent to us and is expected to remain at \$8,400.00.

**New Business-** The Hazardous Mitigation Plan contract needs to be signed, but Bud had questions regarding some wording. He will contact them for clarification.

He also received a letter from a resident on Graves Road regarding plowing. This area is a Class 4 road. Bud will contact VLCT for guidance.

The preliminary General Fund and Highway budgets were reviewed.

The end of the year meeting will be held December 28, 2016 at 7:00 PM.

Orders were signed.
