

**Town of Baltimore
Board of Selectman Meeting
November 2, 2016**

The meeting was brought to order at 7:00 P.M.

Comments and Concerns- None

Secretary's Report- Motion made and seconded to accept minutes. Carried.

Treasurer's Report- Motion made and seconded to accept report. Carried.

Carl Spaulding from the Hawks Mountain Snowmobile Club asked permission for the groomer to use part of Old Piper Road to maintain the local snowmobile trails. An insurance confirmation has already been received. As no complaints have been received, the consensus was to agree. The Sheriff could monitor if problems arise during the winter.

Road Commissioner- The grants were put together by Katherine Otto of Regional Planning, and the bids went over by about \$1,500.00. The culvert by Hammond's is filled with silt and needs to be cleaned out. Apparently the sand collected before the ditch could be lined with stone. There were complaints received about the steep culvert by Stanton's which is currently marked with a stake. Orson said the person that he contacted about mowing can do it now, but it was decided that since it's so late in the year, to wait until next summer. Signs for the bus stop have been erected and it is reported that the bus has resumed stopping in town. Grading is progressing.

Delinquent Tax Collector- No report

Solid Waste- Wayne had copies of the Recycling Coordinator's Report for October 2016. He mentioned it included interesting information about paint recycling.

Old Business- Regional Planning completed a traffic count that had been requested for the Graves Road/Quarry Road link. It indicated an average daily count of 26 vehicles. It also included the times of the traffic. It is unsure when the ambulance contract is up this needs to be checked for establishing the budget for 2018. Also Bud will contact Gurney's for a new winter road agreement for 2016-2017.

New Business- The next meeting will be December 7 and the budgeting process for 2018 will start then.
