**TOWN WARNING**  
**For Annual Town Meeting**

The legal voters of the Town of Baltimore, Vermont are hereby notified and warned to meet in the Baltimore Town Hall on Tuesday, March 5, 2019 at 7:30 o'clock in the evening to act on the following articles.

**Article I:** To elect a moderator for the year ensuing.

**Article II:** To act on Town Reports of the Town.

**Article III:** To elect all Town Officials as the law directs.

**Article IV:** Shall the voters authorize a total GENERAL FUND expenditure of \$53,800.00, of which \$38,800.00 to be raised by taxes and \$15,000.00 carried forward from 2018 year-end General Fund surplus to cover anticipated 2020 Town operating expenses?

**Article V:** Shall the voters approve the transfer of \$12,000.00 from the 2018 General Fund surplus into the General Fund Contingency to meet unanticipated Town operating expenses?

**Article VI:** Shall the voters authorize a total HIGHWAY FUND expenditure of \$87,000.00, of which \$44,000.00 shall be raised by taxes, \$19,000.00 from anticipated State Aid Revenue, and \$24,000.00 carried forward from 2018 year-end Highway Fund surplus to cover anticipated 2020 Highway expenses?

**Article VII:** Shall the voters approve the transfer of \$7,000.00 from the 2018 Highway Fund surplus into the Highway Expense Contingency Fund to meet unanticipated highway expenses?

**Article VIII:** Shall the voters approve the transfer of \$3,000.00 from the 2018 Highway Fund surplus into the Highway Equipment Fund?

**Article IX: (Petitioned Article)** Shall the town appropriate \$244.00 to the Women's Freedom Center for general budget support to provide services to domestic and sexual assault survivors and their children in the town, in accordance with 24 V.S.A. § 2691?

**Article X:** Shall the voters instruct the Selectboard to gather information in providing domestic and traffic certified law enforcement by neighboring towns?

**Article XI:** To see what date in 2019 the town will set for the payment of local property taxes to be paid into the Town Treasury.

**Article XII:** To do any other Town business legal and proper when met not to involve expenditures of the Town.
