**For Annual Town Meeting**

The legal voters of the Town of Baltimore, Vermont are hereby notified and warned to meet in the Baltimore Town Hall on Tuesday, March 3, 2020 at 7:30 o'clock in the evening to act on the following articles.

**Article I:** To elect a moderator for the year ensuing.

**Article II:** To act on Town Reports of the Town.

**Article III:** To elect all Town Officials as the law directs.

**Article IV:** Shall the voters authorize a total GENERAL FUND expenditure of \$55,144.00, of which \$54,144.00 to be raised by taxes and \$1,000.00 carried forward from 2019 year-end General Fund surplus to cover anticipated 2021 Town operating expenses?

**Article V:** Shall the voters approve the transfer of \$1,000.00 from the 2019 General Fund surplus into the General Fund Contingency to meet unanticipated Town operating expenses?

**Article VI:** Shall the voters authorize a total HIGHWAY FUND expenditure of \$91,200.00, of which \$58,200.00 shall be raised by taxes, \$19,000.00 from anticipated State Aid Revenue, and \$14,000.00 carried forward from 2019 year-end Highway Fund surplus to cover anticipated 2021 Highway expenses?

**Article VII:** Shall the voters approve the transfer of \$1,000.00 from the 2019 Highway Fund surplus into the Highway Expense Contingency Fund to meet unanticipated highway expenses?

**Article VIII: (Petitioned Article)** Shall the town appropriate an increase to \$300.00 as donation to The Current to provide transportation services to residents in the Town of Baltimore, in accordance with 24 V.S.A. § 2691?

**Article IX:** To see what date in 2020 the town will set for the payment of local property taxes to be paid into the Town Treasury.

**Article X:** To do any other Town business legal and proper when met not to involve expenditures of the Town.
