Selectboard Meeting  
November 3, 2021**

The meeting was brought to order at 7:00 P.M.

**Comments and Concerns-** John Arrison, Representative of spoke of the pros and cons of the current redistricting. He is currently the representative of Weathersfield and Cavendish. After the last 2020 Census and changes in population, the State of Vermont needs to change some districts to ensure Vermonters have equal representation. Baltimore is currently in a district which includes Chester, Andover and part of North Springfield. The proposed district would include Baltimore, Weathersfield and Cavendish.

**Secretary's Report-** Motion made and seconded to accept minutes. Carried with correction.

**Treasurer's Report-** Motion made and seconded to accept report. Carried.

Deb mentioned that the new ARPA accounts were not established and will contact the bank tomorrow.

**Road Commissioner-** Orson said he had got some grading done. He mentioned that the State doesn't want projects started after November 15 due to seasonal weather changes. Also, there were some work on drainage ditching crossing the road near Loomis'.

**Old Business-** Tom Kennedy of Regional Planning is a great resource for confirming proper use of the American Rescue funds. Stormwater, culverts and digitalizing land records are possible uses.
