Board of Selectmen Meeting
April 6, 2022

The meeting was brought to order at 7:00 P.M.

Comments and Concerns- None

Secretary's Report- Motion made and seconded to accept minutes. Carried.

Treasurer's Report- Motion made and seconded to accept report. Carried.

Grants were reviewed. Wayne had applied for a \$15,000 Better Roads Grant (MRGP), but it is unknown where it stands.

Road Commissioner- Roads are drying well and Orson has scraped the high spots and will put gravel over the stoned areas. Megan sent an email asking for a rough estimate of the amount spent to repair the roads this spring. Bud will send her an email detailing the additional expense.

There was discussion about rising costs and prices. Orson mentioned that he hadn't had a raise in over ten years. Bud suggested we discuss this at our next meeting and reminded us that there is usually a difference in the budgeted amount and the amount actually spent.

Delinquent Tax Collector- Janet received money from TR Williams and the Reed estate. She has asked Martha some questions regarding these, but hasn't heard back.

Solid Waste- Bud received a note from Mary O'Brien that a position was vacant. John explained that their meeting time changed and Becky is, most often, no longer able to attend. Bud will advise her that Wayne is our representative and Becky is alternate.

Old Business- ARPA Funds-Bud would like to create a list of items to consider for use of ARPA funding to be submitted to Jason and VLCT for review and feedback if they qualify.

New Business- Dan would like to go around town and, with input from Orson and Wayne, mark trees and branches that need removal. He will then submit an estimate for the work.

Orders and contracts were signed.
