Old Business- Wayne ordered a mower to clean the roadsides.
Deb mentioned she is working to get quotes for digitizing the Land Records.
Wayne had copies of the Regional Planning Commission 2022 Regional Plan for Transportation. He also mentioned that he had spoken with Bay regarding grants for new hydrants.

New Business- The new Education tax rates were received. The tax rate for 2023 is 2.1453 for Homestead and 2.2120 for Non Homestead.
