

**Town of Baltimore  
Selectmen Meeting  
September 12, 2023**

Attending: Sandy Rich, Wayne Wheelock, Walter Rich, Bay Wheeler, Dan Cox Kevin Gould, Donald Roys, and Derek Bruce

The meeting was brought to order at 7:00 P.M.

**Comments and Concerns-** Kevin mentioned that the Baltimore cemetery was in need of maintenance due to a large number of small tree growth throughout the grounds. Kevin asked if maybe there was grant money available or personnel available to aid in returning the cemetery back to a decent looking area. There were some people that said they would help in that regard and Bud said that there was money in the cemetery fund and ARPA money might be used. Also, we could check with Regional to see if a grant is available.

**Secretary's Report-** Motion made and seconded to accept minutes. Carried.

**Treasurer's Report-** Motion made and seconded to accept report. Carried.

**Grant Status-** Bud reported that the state sent a notice that read that the state will provide a one-year extension until September 30,2024, on state fiscal year 2023 Grant in Aid awards. This was good news for the town as our grant in aid indicated that the end date was September 30, 2023 and the town did not have a contractor to do the work that was available because of the July flood problem.

**Delinquent Tax-** No report submitted.

**Highway-** It was reported that two people contacted the town and said that they would be willing to provide service that included the grading of the town roads. The Selectboard voted to restructure the Highway personal by appointing Wayne Wheelock to be the Town Road Commissioner and appointing Derik Bruce as a town employee as Equipment Operator and recognizing Donald Roys as contractor available to operate the Town grader. It was noted that a culvert at the north end of town needs to be replaced with a larger culvert which hasn't been done yet. The contractor that was to do the job was still tied up with storm related work in another town.

**Old Business –** Bud has been working with Guney Brothers in correcting an error with the invoicing of the cost of snow plowing. This has now been resolved and money that is now due back to the town will be credited to the following Winter Maintenance cost for the 2023-2024 season.

Bay Wheeler will be contacting a service that specializes in correcting water or moisture accumulation such as what the town is experiencing in the basement of the town office.

Wayne gave out information regarding cost bids for the town office maintenance plan which included the water or moisture problem in the basement of the town office.

Orders were signed.

The meeting was adjourned at 8:20 PM.
