

**Town of Baltimore  
Selectboard Meeting  
September 10, 2024**

*Attending: Sandy Rich, Wayne Wheelock, Walter Rich, George Wheeler, Dan Cox and Deb Bean.*

The meeting was brought to order at 7:00 P.M.

**Comments and Concerns-** Bay mentioned a resident who appears lax in obtaining permitting. Permits must be secured within 30 days. This person has a generator but no driveway permit. He will stop and speak with him.

**Secretary's Report-** There was no report as there was no quorum.

**Treasurer's Report-** Motion made and seconded to accept report. Carried.

**Grants:** GA 084 Grant in Aid-This has two segments which have been completed and we should be receiving the funding soon.

Structures Grant-This is the engineering grant to study culvert replacement. This has been received and Bud will verify that it is good to go.

Grant in Aid 25 for \$2,500. Wayne has a segment to do and we have until September 2025.

There is a possible grant for a generator. Malia is working on it. It is for critical use, and as the town office is the Town's only building, it should qualify.

**Delinquent Tax Collector-** No report completed.

**Road Commissioner-** The road has been graded and some potholes removed. Stinger bits have been put on the blade and chloride on the road. Wayne had hoped to hear from Don regarding gravel from Cerosimo at a discounted price. Dan will check with Derek about grading and putting gravel down.

It is hoped that the Bemis turnaround will be completed before snow. Crown Point is doing this. Gravel also needs to be added near Constantines.

Bud mentioned he received a notice from the State that the Highway funds will be released to us early.

**ARPA Status-** Digitizing the land records, search computer and basement humidity control (Twin State Basement) water filter and outside faucet have been approved. We are awaiting the signed contract from Twin State. After some discussion, it was decided to get an oil furnace and table the generator as we explore other funding options for it. Bud will get a bid from H & B and have Don's Heating resend their bill. Bay will check with Malia about grant expectations.

**Old Business-** None

**New Business-** Sandy mentioned that she and Deb caught and eliminated two mice which have caused havoc in the desks.
