Selectboard Meeting
February 5, 2026**

Attending: Sandy Rich, Steve Waldo, Wayne Wheelock, Walter Rich, George Wheeler, David Sigl and Deb Bean.

The meeting was brought to order at 7:00 P.M.

Comments and Concerns- One resident had complained about trash containers in the roadway awaiting collection.

Another complained about the aggregate used on the roads. They believe it gets caught in the tires and hits the car.

Steve had a neighbor's dog attack his dog which was leashed on his property. His dog suffered some minor injuries.

Currently we don't have an active constable or animal control officer. We do contract with the Springfield Humane Society.

A registered letter was sent to 39B. Bay received a phone call on regarding the campers and driveway. He will check with Steve Ankuda regarding options.

Treasurer's Report- Motion was made and seconded with correction noted. Carried

Solid Waste: Steve is getting up to speed on this. Alva was at their last meeting. Springfield does an excellent job with sorting glass. There are thoughts that the landfill may not be able to continue.

Old Business- David is waiting to hear back from Ken regarding the Lister's computer.

Bay spoke with someone regarding being the Road Commissioner, but he was not interested in the paperwork side of the position

New Business- The Town should revisit having a constable or have someone be an animal control officer.

It was noted that some people are continuing from Old Piper Road onto Old Piper Trail. It was thought that there should be signs advising people that the road ends.
