

**Town of Baltimore
Selectboard Meeting
April, 2026**

Attending: Brian Decatur, Penny Decatur, Wayne Wheelock, Kevin Gould, Sandy Rich, Walter Rich, George Wheeler, David Sigl and Deb Bean.

The meeting was brought to order at 7:00 P.M.

Comments and Concerns- Brian mentioned how good he felt our roads were during mud season. Bay wanted to thank everyone for coming and trying to make things better for our small community. He hopes more residents become involved. Kevin was curious if our equipment operator was compensated and indeed, he is.

Secretary's Report- Motion was made and seconded to accept minutes of March 4. Carried. After checking the statutes (any two of Justices, Moderator or Selectboard members for approval), motions made and seconded to approve minutes of the March 3 Town Meeting. Carried.

Treasurer's Report- Motion was made and seconded. Carried.

Grants- Grants in Aid needs a signature. Bud signed it and will send it back. Bud signed a letter of intent for 2027 Grants in Aid and will send that in. We will have to address the culverts and get bids.

Old Business- Bay had brochures for Project Action which has been useful to help people connect with agencies. They meet once a week. Bay mentioned that a letter was sent to 39 Baltimore and will contact our attorney for additional ideas. It was mentioned that to certify a constable, that person must go to the academy, have a vehicle, firearm and insurance. This cost is difficult for smaller communities.

New Business- David is in the process of rewriting the by-laws and allowable and conditional uses.

The form to complete road standards was signed and will be returned.

There was discussion about the need for Chester to receive the school ballots during the time our Town Meeting is held and that person is limited in their ability to attend.

Bay signed the form for 2027 Grant in Aid and Wayne will deliver to Meghan. Wayne agreed to work on the Grant.

The Road Commissioner needs a job description and hours worksheet. We expect that Town Officers will be having their own Town emails.

A motion was made and seconded to allow regular, recurring bills, i.e. Green Mountain Power and TDS, to be paid before approval via signed orders so they can be paid in a timely manner. Carried.
